CHEMISTRY (CH25)

The Chemistry major provides a broad introduction for the biochemistry, organic, physical, or inorganic student as well as those who prefer not to specialize. This major will enable a student to pursue further studies in chemistry or in related fields of science, medicine, or engineering. The plan below assumes completion of CHEM 6A, 6B, 6C, 7L, 40A, 40B, 40C, 43A, MATH 20A, 20B, 20C*, 20D*, and PHYS 2A, 2B, 2C* or 2D*, and 2BL* or 2CL* or 2DL* prior to transferring to UCSD.

We do not recommend taking a chemistry lab your first quarter at UCSD. Plan to take no more than one lab per quarter starting your second quarter.
